
## TREKKING BLACK ROCK DEVIL'S ØATE





Devils Gate is on Lost Creek Road about 7.7 miles as you head east from Rt447. It can be accessed coming from the east and Rt34 and while it is the "scenic route" you need an SUV or Truck. Coming in from Rt447 a regular car can possibly make the trip.

Devil's Gate is a divide between harsh Nevada desert and green sylvan woods. Birch trees and shrubs are fed by a babbling brook of nice cool water. The place is a haven for all sorts of animals. Everything on the other side of the "gate" is brown and dry. This is an oasis.

There are deer, rabbits, owls and, like all of Northwestern Nevada, lizards. The surrounding hills are mostly volcanic rock including Tufa, Granite and Basalt, plus a bunch of other stuff.
